Rules:

Memorization of solos is optional.

An original copy of the music must be provided for the judge. (An additional photocopy is suggested for the judge to mark directly on.) Measures must be numbered. Please provide full score for ensembles.

Works should not exceed 8 minutes in length. Multi-movement works are acceptable.

Works with accompaniment must be performed with accompaniment. (See below for pianist contact information.) Commercially recorded accompaniments are allowed for auditions, but grades 9-12 must use a live pianist for the Honor Recital.

Ensembles may be any size and instrumentation, but at least one player must be a flutist and OFS member. Each solo and/or ensemble requires a separate entry fee.

Tentative Schedule of Events:

Judging will begin early afternoon, depending on the number of entries, to end at 3:30pm.

Activities will be available for students who wish to stay on site.

4:00--Honor Recital--Outstanding High School Soloist announced at the conclusion of the recital.
